Clap Watch

Circular Multiplication Clap Watch (Multiplications table, rhytm and movement coordination)

Description:

Create a circle with you as the teacher in the middle. Start stomping in a rhythm that you, as the teacher, can maintain while speaking and moving. Keep it slow; it tends to speed up naturally. Point at each student and say numbers together with them, counting as you turn around. If you are using the 5 tables, have each child who ends up on 5, 10, 15, 20 clap to mark the number.

Ideas to use:

- 1. As the game progresses, you can change the tables for more variation. You can also alternate the direction of pointing or have the pointing move randomly within the circle, without following a specific direction. This way, they cannot predict who becomes the clapper.
- 2. To make it more challenging, you can remove the element of voice, relying solely on memory, calculations, and rhythm.
